IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION TO CANDIDATES

- For Recruiting Year 2023-24, the recruitment of Agniveer GD (Women Military Police) will be carried out in two phases:-
 - Phase I - Online Computer Based Written Examination (Online Common Entrance Exam).
 - Phase II - Recruitment Rally.
- Procedure for Online Registration.**
 - All candidates to log in to joinindianarmy.nic.in, check their eligibility status and create their profile.
 - Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from 16 February 2023 to 15 March 2023.
 - Examination Fee.** Examination fee of Rs 250/- per applicant is to be paid by the candidate for the online examination. The candidate on successfully filling the application will be directed to SBI portal through a link on the website. At the SBI portal make payment of Rs 250/- plus Bank charges as applicable. The payment can be made through any of these payment options available:-
 - Payment Gateway Facility through Maestro, Master Card, VISA, Rupay Cards both Credit and Debit of all major banks.
 - Internet banking of SBI and other banks.
 - UPI (Bhim).
 - Duplicate/ Incomplete/ Erroneously filled application will be rejected.
 - Candidates are required to have an active email and mobile number which will be used for further communication.
 - Candidates should apply only once in response to this notification.
 - Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All possible efforts would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - Candidates not reporting for the test on due date and time will not be accommodated on other dates.
 - Candidate should enter **AADHAR** number in online application.
 - For online registration and online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at nearest Army Recruiting Office on working days from 1000 Hours to 1400 hours.
- Online Common Entrance Exam.**
 - Category wise link has been provided on Join Indian Army website to enable candidates to practice online Common Entrance Exam as per their category. All candidates are advised to carry out practice at least once before appearing for actual Common Entrance Exam.
 - Animated videos "How to Register" and "How to Appear for online Common Entrance Exam" are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in
- Candidates are advised to upload only recent photographs on Join Indian Army website. In case of uploaded photographs not matching with face, candidate will not be allowed to appear in the online Common Entrance Exam.
- Candidates are to reach at the examination Centre with colour print out of admit card. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in online test in case anomalies/irregularities / incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of selection process.
- The candidates should carry his **AADHAR** Card (as displayed on the Admit Card) as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test (Phase-I and II) and Medical Test.
- Details about required educational qualification, physical/ medical standards and job specification are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in under the candidate's login and this information can be accessed by the candidate without signing in.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The selection of candidates will be carried out for following category as per qualitative requirement:-

Candidates who have appeared in class 10th and class 12th Board Exam and are awaiting declaration of results are also eligible to apply provided they fulfill all other Qualitative requirement. Such candidates, however, shall only be selected when they produce the original mark sheet during the Phase II of recruitment process (Internet copy of mark sheet not acceptable) as also such candidates should secure the minimum laid down marks in aggregate as well as in individual subjects for respective category for being eligible to participate in Phase II – Recruitment Rally. 2. Women who are widowed, divorced or legally separated are also eligible provided they do not have any children subject to fulfilling all other eligibility criteria. 3. Widows of Defence personnel who have died in harness will be eligible to apply for enrollment as Women Military Police. Such widows even with children will be, however, eligible only if they have not remarried. 		

2. **Date of Birth:** Candidate born between **01 Oct 2002 to 01 April 2006** (both days inclusive) are eligible to apply.

3. **Physical Standards.**

(a) **Height.** 162 centimeters.

(b) **Weight.** Proportionate to height and age as per Army Medical standards.

(c) **Chest Expansion.** The candidate should be capable of chest expansion of five centimeters.

4. **Special Physical Standards.** Candidates belonging to following regions will be given four centimeters height relaxation:-

(a) **North East Region.** Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya and Assam.

(b) **Gorkhas.**

(c) **Garhwalis.**

Note:- Domicile and Caste Certificate will be considered to determine applicability of height relaxation.

Note :-

- (i) The above marks are fixed depending upon the eligibility of a candidate and has no relation to his performance in Common Entrance Examination (CEE).
- (ii) Maximum bonus marks that can be given is 25 Marks even if a candidate qualifies for more than one type of bonus marks.
- (iii) Only one ward (daughter/ son) of Service/ Ex-Servicemen/ War Widow/ Widow of Ex-servicemen can avail bonus marks in written examination.
- (iv) Original Certificates to be carried by all above categories at rally site.
- (v) Sports Certificate are valid for two years from the issue date as on first day of the recruitment rally for which the candidate is being screened.
- (vi) In case a candidate is found to have made fake claims at any stage or furnished fake Certificate to unfairly secure Bonus Marks, his candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage of recruitment.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

7. AGNIVEER will be enrolled in the Indian Army under Indian Army Act 1950 for a period of four years. AGNIVEER would form a distinct rank in the Indian army, different from any other existing ranks. Indian Army is not obliged to retain AGNIVEER beyond the engagement period of four years.

8. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Army, AGNIVEER will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Indian Army. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria including performances during their four year engagement period and upto 25% of each specific batch of AGNIVEER will be enrolled in regular cadre of Indian Army. **AGNIVEER will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Army. Selection of the AGNIVEER for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Indian Army.**

9. **Employability.** AGNIVEER enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, at the discretion of the Indian army.

10. **Training.** On being enrolled, AGNIVEER will be imparted military training based on Indian Army requirement.

11. **Leave.** Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of Indian Army. The following leave may be applicable for Agniveer during their engagement period :-

- (a) Annual Leave : 30 days per year.
- (b) Sick Leave : Based on medical advice.

12. **Medical and Canteen Store Department (CSD) Facilities.** For the duration of their engagement period in Indian Army, AGNIVEER will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as Canteen Store Department provisions.

13. **Pay, Allowances and Allied Benefits.** AGNIVEER enrolled under this scheme will be paid an AGNIVEER package with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (as applicable in Indian Army), Dress and Travel allowances will be paid.

14. **Terminal Benefits – Seva Nidhi Package.** AGNIVEER will be given one time 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

NOTE: 1 AGNIVEER will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund of the Government.

NOTE: 2 There shall be no entitlement to any gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits in case of AGNIVEER.

15. **Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation.** AGNIVEER will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of Rs 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as AGNIVEER in the Indian Army. AGNIVEER will not be governed by provisions contained in the Pension Regulations/Rules for Indian Army.

16. **Agniveer Skill Certificate.** At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill-Set certificate will be provided to the AGNIVEER highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during **their engagement period.**

17. Personnel enrolled under this Scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen Status.

18. Only unmarried candidates will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveers and they must undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Agniveers who marry during the said period would be released from service. Further, only unmarried Agniveer will be eligible for re-enrolment in regular cadre as Sepoy/ equivalent on selection as currently in vogue. Additionally, Women Agniveers would be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such Women Agniveers on becoming Low Medical Category due to pregnancy are liable to be discharged /dismissed /released, as applicable, from service on administrative grounds post medical opinion.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

19. **Recruitment Process.** Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases. **Phase I** will be Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India and **Phase 2** will be Recruitment Rally by Army Recruiting Offices at Rally venue.

Phase I

20. **Online Common Entrance Exam.**

(a) Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his user name (which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by Short Message System (SMS)/Electronic mail (E-mail).

(b) Candidates should download their Admit Card and carry a colour printout at the exam centre. All instructions given on Admit Card must be read by the candidates carefully and they should adhere to the instructions.

(c) Entry gates at exam centre will be opened one and a half hours prior to scheduled time of exams and will close 30 minutes prior to time of exam. No candidate will be allowed to enter once the entrance gate is closed.

(d) No electronic gadgets are permitted at the examination centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centre:-

- (i) Frisking at Entry Gate.
- (ii) Checking of Admit Card and Aadhar Card at the checking point
- (iii) Auto allotment of Exam Hall.
- (iv) Attendance at Exam Hall gate.

- (v) Capture of Biometric (Photo and thumb impression) inside the exam hall.
 - (vi) Login ID to allotted computer terminal.
 - (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
 - (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.
- (e) Online test will be objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hour or 100 questions in two hours.
- (f) Marking pattern for online test:-
- (i) Full marks for every correct answer.
 - (ii) Nil marks for unattempted question.
 - (iii) 25% marks shall be deducted for every attempted wrong answer (negative marks).
 - (iv) All questions, if attempted, will be considered for evaluation, even if marked for review.
- (g) Marks scored by the candidates in Online Common Entrance Exam will be normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.
21. Additional information for candidates till Phase I of the selection process:-
- (a) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - (b) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - (c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date and time will not be accommodated on other dates.
 - (d) In case any candidate is found using unfair means, the candidate will not be allowed to complete the exam and the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled.

Phase – II

22. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in written exam result. The Roll Number of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a second admit card for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of Zonal Recruiting Offices. The admit card for Phase II of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army website portal <https://joinindianarmy.nic.in>. Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for Phase II at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following document /certificate in original alongwith two attested photocopies with them:-

- (a) **Admit Card**. Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
- (b) **Photograph**. Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old Computerised/ photocopied/ shopped photographs will **NOT be accepted**.

(c) **Education Certificates.**

(i) Education Certificate with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/ Intermediate Etcetera from recognised School/ College/ Board/ University.

(ii) Provisional/online education certificate should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University.

(iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by Block Education Officer (BEO)/ District Education Officer (DEO).

(iv) List of Education Boards recognised by State Governments/ Union Territory (UT) administrations is attached as **Appendix 'A'** will only be accepted.

(d) **Domicile Certificate.** Domicile Certificate with photograph issued by Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.

(e) **Caste Certificate.** Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.

(f) **Religion Certificate.** Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ Sub Divisional Magistrate (SDM). (if religion as "**SIKH/ HINDU/ MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN**" is not mentioned in caste certificate).

(g) **School Character Certificate.** School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster where the candidates last studied.

(h) **Character Certificate.** Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation **within last six months** from the date of despatch.

(j) **Unmarried Certificate.** Unmarried Certificate for all candidates with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation **within last six months.**

(k) **Relationship Certificate.** DOS/DOEX/DOW/DOWW candidates are required to produce the following documents :-

(i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship Certificate should bear water marks of the concerned Records.

(ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the Ex-Servicemen (ESM) duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'B'.**

(iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

(l) **NCC Certificate.** **NCC A/B/C Certificate** and **Republic Day Parade** certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. **NCC A/B/C pass certificates in original will only be accepted.** No bonus marks in the final merit to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/ Sports/ NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.

(m) **Sports Certificate.**

(i) Sportsmen who have represented India at international level and State at National level within the last two years as per paragraph 6 (b) above (for list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible, attention is invited to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website).

(ii) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team or regional team at District level within last two years with position or medal as per paragraph 6 (b) above (Sports Certificate should be with registration number and from government recognised sport institutes/ bodies).

(iii) **List of Sports.** List of Sports for enrolment is attached as **Appendix 'C'**.

(n) **Affidavit.** Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. **Format of affidavit attached as per Appendix 'D'. Submission of Affidavit is mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.**

(o) **Certificate of Bonus Marks.** All original certificates/ photocopies duly attested pertaining to bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim bonus marks/ relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.

(p) **PAN Card and AADHAR Card.** PAN Card and Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay and Allowances and other social benefits scheme.

(q) Police Character Certificate.

(r) Sarpanch/ Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof).

(s) **Tattoo.**

(i) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates: -

(aa) Self certification certificate to be signed by the candidates is attached as **Appendix 'E-I'**.

(ab) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent Body Tattoo(s) to be signed by District Collector/ District Magistrate or Sub Divisional Magistrate of the District/ Tehsil where the tribe of the candidates is presently settled is attached as **Appendix 'E-II'** (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).

(ii) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

23. Candidates will be tested as stated below during the Phase II:-

(b) <u>Physical Measurement Test (At Rally Site).</u>		Physical measurement will be carried out as per the laid down physical standards.	
(c) <u>Medical Examination.</u>			
(i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Tests and Physical Measurement Tests will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.			
(ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to Military Hospital for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within five days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within seven days as per policy.			
(iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination, review medical examination and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.			
(iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.			
(v) <u>Gender.</u> Any candidate if found to have predominantly masculine characteristics evidenced on external physical examination, will be rejected as UNFIT. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared UNFIT.			

(vi) **Pregnancy.** Any female candidate, if found to be pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature rejected. A candidate should not have conceived at the time of reporting, till conclusion of training at Corps of Military Police Centre and School and during four years of engagement period as Agniveer. A Medical Certificate from a Government Medical Doctor (with minimum MBBS qualification) stating the no pregnant status of a candidate will be produced on reporting for the recruitment rally, and a fresh certificate again, when reporting to the Training Centre, failing which the individual will be rejected summarily.

Note : Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

24. **Special Instructions.**

- (a) **Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase –II, five days prior to the Rally, may approach nearest Army Recruiting Office for further clarification.**
- (b) **01 October 2023** will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate/ 10th class marksheet at the time of preliminary document check.
- (c) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by **0400** hours on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after **0600** hours without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (d) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/Mobile Number like short listed/call letter/joining instruction/result Etcetera.
